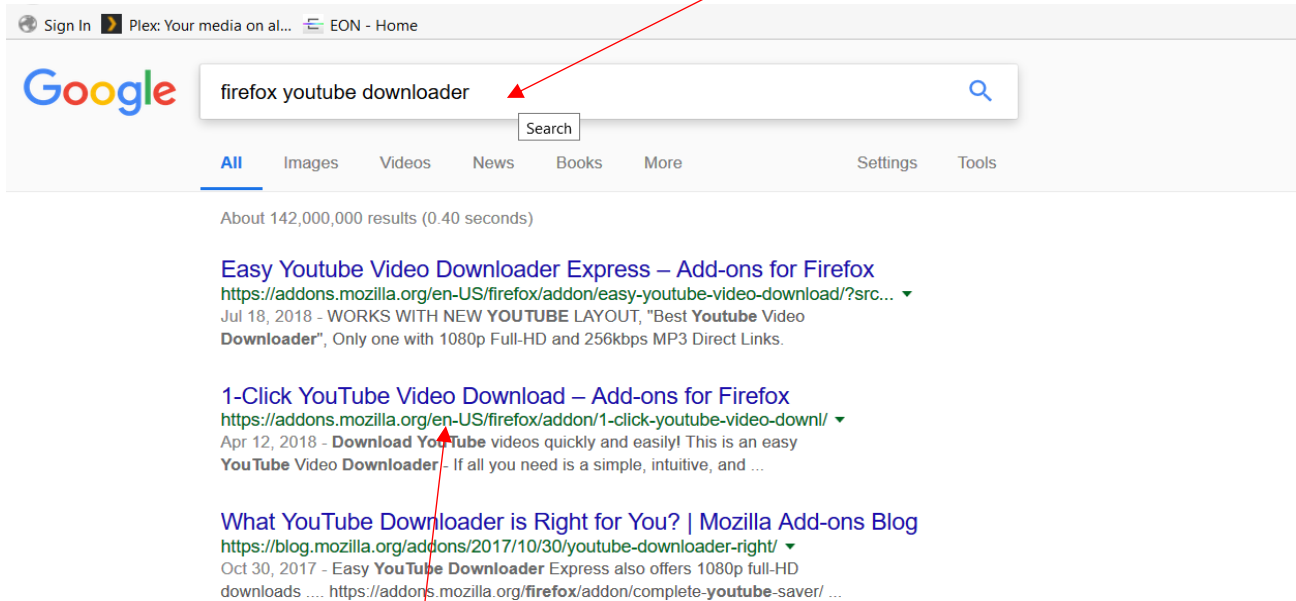


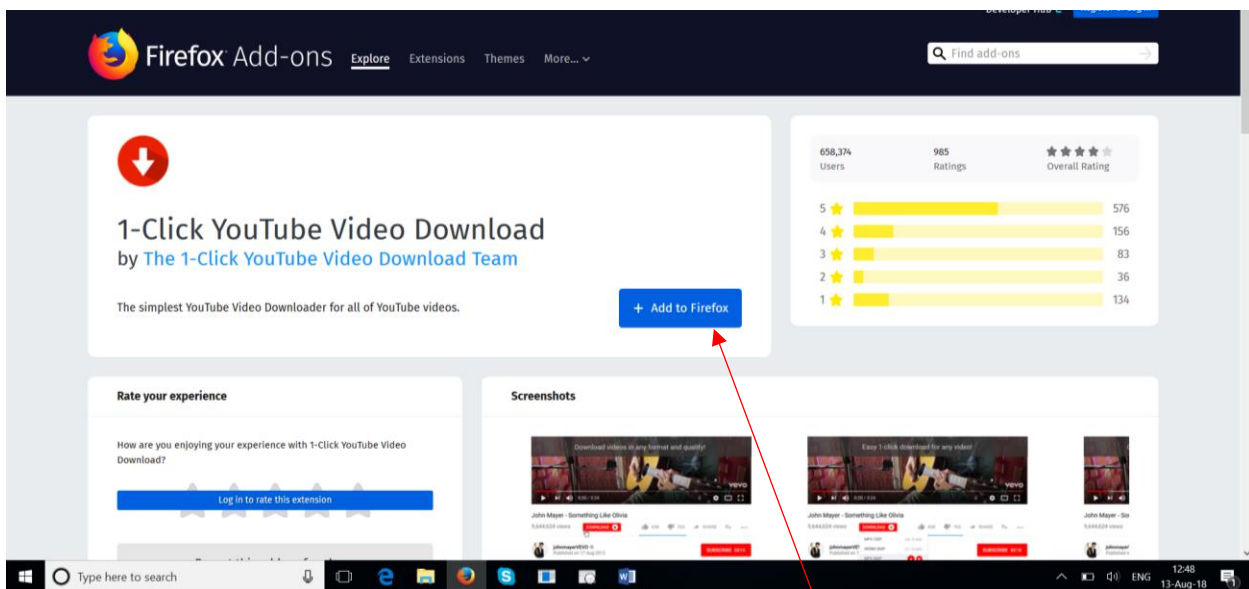
## Downloading games from Youtube.

Firstly you need to have Firefox as a browser.

Secondly open Firefox and in the search engine type Firefox YouTube downloader. You should see the results in the screen shot below.

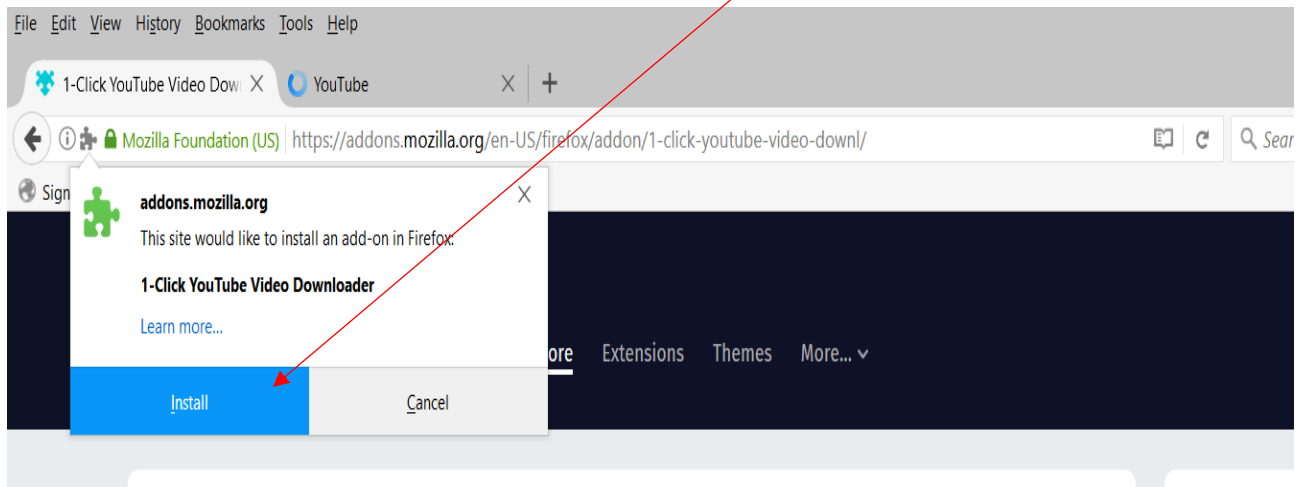


Once you have completed this click on the second option or the one that is the same as the second one in the list above.



You should see this screen next. Click on the blue box that says + add to Firefox.

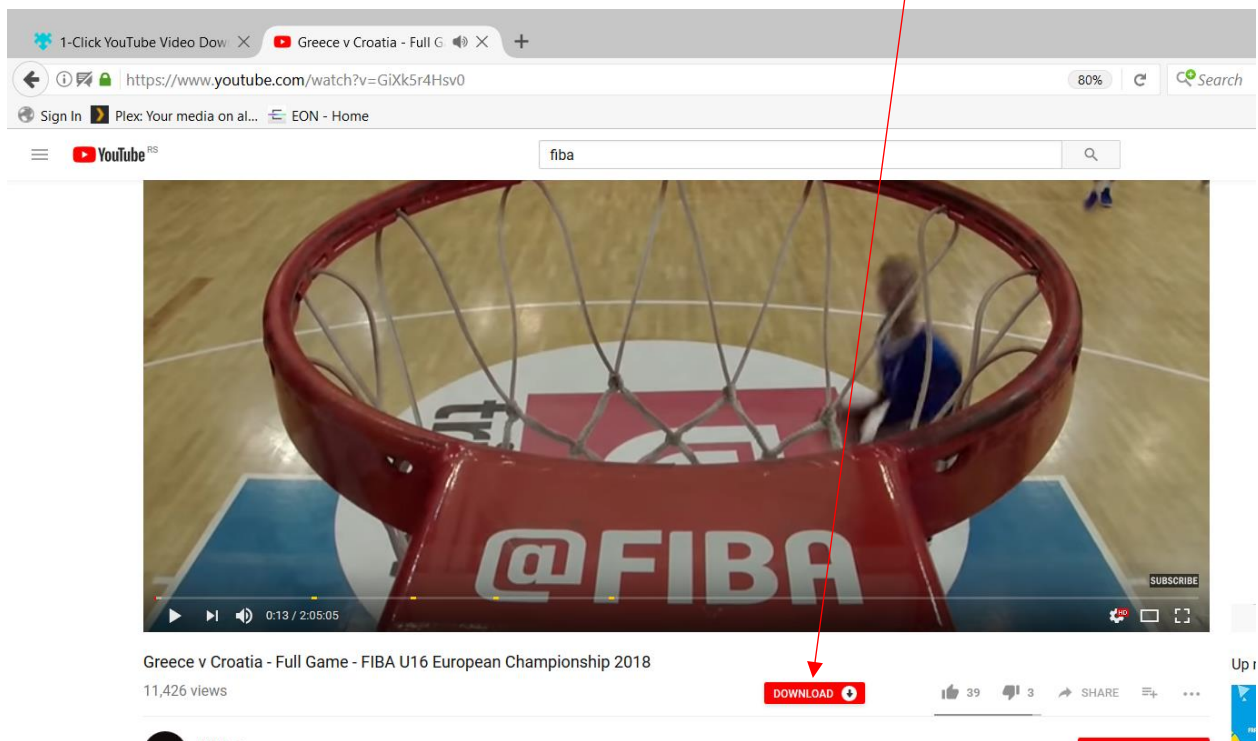
Next you will see a dialogue box asking you to install the add on. Click on the install button.



Once the install has completed you can close the window.

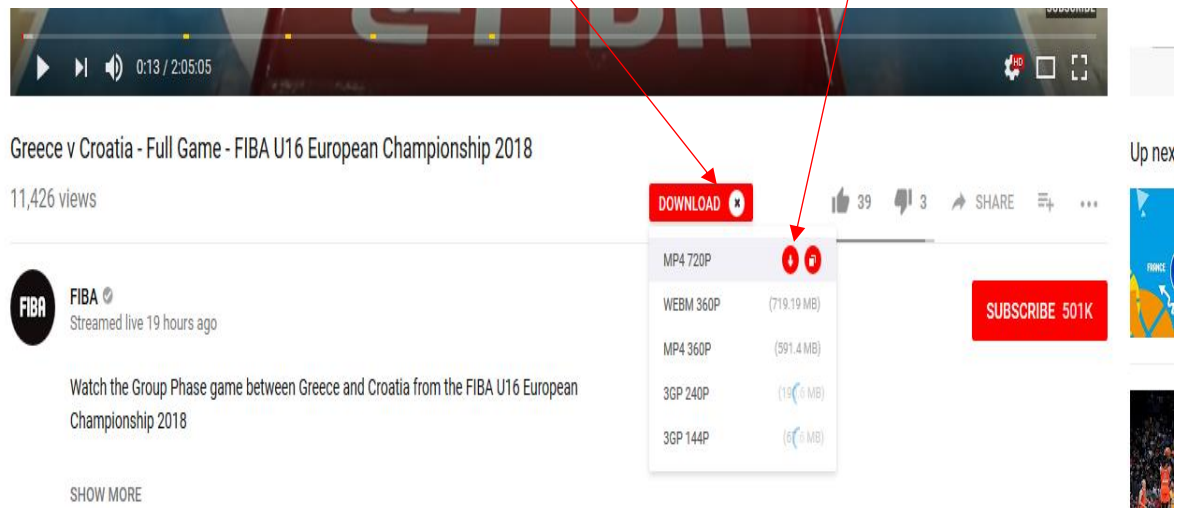
To check that it has worked, open a new window on Firefox and go to the FIBA channel on YouTube and select any game that is not Live (you can not download any game that still shows that it is currently live).

On your browser window you should now have a small red box that says download.



Click on the white arrow on the download box and you will have a selection of download options. I always use MP4 720p it is excellent quality.

Once you have the option menu, click the white arrow next to the type of file you wish to download. AS pop up menu will appear and ask you where you would like to save the file to. Make your selection and then the download will begin.



To check on the download progress you will now have an arrow in the top corner that is working through the process click on this and it will show you the download taking place.
